RULES

- 1. Open to all C.T.F. British Columbia members aged 50 or over as of date of participation.
- 2. Entrants will use their highest 2017/18 C.T.F. sanctioned winter average based on a minimum of 21 games. If no average for the previous season, their highest current C.T.F. sanctioned average for 21 games or more as of the date of participation will be used. All others bowl scratch (210). Entrants who participate in more than one League or Association shall use their highest average.
- 3. Average to be verified by Tournament Manager. See Rule 319a-5. The Executive reserves the right to reclassify any entrant prior to participation. C.T.F. Rules 319a-2, 319a-3 and 319d, are waived. Tournament manager reserve the right to re-rate bowlers as necessary.
- 4. Handicap will be 100% of 210 per entrant, per event - No Limit.
- 5. *Entry Fee is:* \$32.00 (\$13.50 lineage, \$12.50 prize fund, 6.00 expenses) All entry fees payable by cheque or money order to <u>BC Tenpin Federation</u> must accompany entry form. No post dated cheques. All prize fees returned 100%. Expense fee covers some USBC Seniors and CTF Team Trial Expenses.
- 6. Bowlers may enter doubles more than once providing they change partners, and singles more than once, but can *cash only once in singles*.
- 7. Bowlers must list their line-up on the entry form in the order they wish to bowl. No changes will be permitted at the time of bowling. Substitutes must report to the Tournament Manager thirty (30) minutes prior to each squad they are entered and must assume the position of the absent bowler they are replacing.
- 8. No more than eight (8) entrants will be scheduled on a pair of lanes.
- 9. It is the responsibility of the entrant/s to ensure entry has been acknowledged.
- 10. Out of Town entries will be given preference of dates and times, providing paid entry is received by Tournament Manager prior to October 15, 2018.
- 11. TELEPHONE and/or EMAIL reservations will be accepted providing entry forms and all fees are received within 7 days of date of reservation.
- 12. No additional squads will be added while lanes are available as advertised.
- 13. Prize ratio will be 1 prize for every 7 entries in both Doubles and Singles events.
- 14. Single and doubles events are one division each. Age classification is only for USBC Seniors.
- 15. The 1st place **male and female Handicap All Event winners** (first three games in doubles plus first three games in singles) in each division will be given the opportunity to represent B.C. at the 2019 USBC Senior Championship Tournament in Cincinnati, Ohio on August 6 to 9, 2019. Ties will be broken by high scratch game. If winner is unable to



participate, alternates in order of finish in the divisions concerned will be contacted. . If winner is unable to participate, alternates in order of finish up to 3rd place in the divisions concerned will be contacted.

Divisions are: "Super Senior" 75 & up - "A" 70 to 74, "B" 65 to 69, "C" 60 to 64, "D" 55 to 59, "E" 50 to 54

USBC Senior shirt will be paid for but participants to the USBC Senior Championship will be responsible for ALL other expenses incurred (Entry Fee, USBC card, Travel, Lodging, Meals)

- 16. The 1st place **male and female Scratch All Events Winners** (first three games in doubles plus first three games in singles) in each division will be given the opportunity to represent B.C. at the 2019 CTF Team Trials. Upon return from team trials each bowler will receive \$200. Ties will be broken by high scratch game. If winner is unable to participate, alternates in order of finish up to 3rd place in the divisions concerned will be contacted.
- 17. For all ties, prize money will be divided equally with the exception of last place, which shall receive no less than the amount designated as the Prize Fee.
- 18. The penalty for violation of any portion of the above rules shall be disqualification and forfeiture of all entry fees.
- 19. Entries will be accepted **up to** 1 hour prior to each Squad if lanes are available.
- 20. All C.T.F. Rules, not printed on this entry form, shall apply.
